



2019-2020 AP EXAM INFORMATION and Updated processes due to school closure

Students currently registered to take an AP exam are ready to test for 2019 – 2020. Testing will take place online this year following the exam schedule provided by College Board.

Key Information:

➤ **Your MyAP Account email address** - College Board will communicate with students who have registered to take AP exams DIRECTLY through the MyAP Account email address. If an AP student has not received emails from The College Board in the last two weeks, this may indicate that there is an error in the email connected to the MyAP account. To correct:

- Log into <http://myap.collegeboard.org> ASAP and navigate to "MyAP Profile" to review that the email address on file is one ACTIVELY checked and used.
- **College Board will send the high security log in credentials that students need to log into the Exam Platform to the student email address on the MyAP account. Without the login access that will be sent by The College Board directly to the student, students will NOT be able to take the AP exam. Plan ahead!**

➤ **Exams with Accommodations** - if a student has already been approved by College Board for accommodations on AP exam(s), these accommodations will automatically be applied by the exam content platform (or site). The accommodations are linked via the SSD Number to the AP ID Number and will be automatic.

➤ **Exam Security** - is being taken VERY seriously! The College Board will apply all the technology resources at their fingertips to maintain the integrity and security of the exams, INCLUDING sending a copy of the work submitted on exam day to the student's AP teacher by May 26, 2020. Review carefully the security details.

➤ **Exam cancellation:** if a student feels the need to cancel an AP exam due to the extended school closures and/or the effects of COVID-19, **exams can be cancelled up to May 19 for a full refund of the amount paid. We ask that students wait to make this decision until they have had time to work with teachers and access the online resources available from College Board.** To request a refund, email cancel@aptsusa.com and **your campus testing coordinator**. Include - name, name of school, exam to cancel. *No refunds will be issued for exams not cancelled by May 19.*

➤ All students testing who earn a qualifying score (3 or higher) will be reimbursed for the price paid for each qualifying exam in August 2020.

Exam fees paid in 2019-2020:

\$80 per test (unless qualified for a scholarship for part)

\$15 per test – students qualifying for free and reduced lunch
